
OVERVIEW

This year, the space in OIE received significant updates including new video conferencing equipment to facilitate hybrid programming, new digital signs, lighting, and new workspaces for graduate student staff. OIE launched new belonging initiatives focused on marginalized students. The 6th annual CHANCE overnight program for high school Hispanic and Latinx students was held in July 2022 with 96 campers in attendance. Since the inaugural CHANCE program in 2017, 425 high school students have attended 4 overnight camps, 49 have attended a one-day event in 2021, and 4 Facebook live events in 2020 have been viewed over 3,107 times.
