

Alcohol Sanctioning Guidelines

Revised July 24, 2019

This document outlines sanctioning options for typical alcohol situations. However, not every situation will be typical and may have extenuating circumstances. Every case is to be taken separately and should be heard with careful consideration given to all circumstances surrounding a decision before a sanction is rendered. These are sanction guidelines; thus, flexibility is given to impose sanctions most appropriate for the given incident.
